Short Overview of the project

With our offer we want to make it possible to experience what citizen-friendly neighbourhood development should look like, how alternative forms of mobility can be used and how stronger social togetherness can put an end to the increasing isolation of many people.

Our disability bikes and rickshaws contribute to more selfdetermined participation for people who are limited in their mobility; we connect people and bring them together.





Problem

- Elderly and mobility impaired people are limited in local entertainment options;
- Obesity, heart diseases, high blood pressure and premature mortality are causes of social isolation, loneliness, depression and inactivity;
- Missed opportunities for attracting tourists in Bournemouth from these categories.







In over-50's, the incidence of loneliness increased by a half from 2017 and it's set to reach 2 million by 2025 and 77% of the disabled people feel the same way







Solution

- a source of recreation and socialization
- increased opportunities to participate in leisure activities
- the chance to enjoy our beaches form another perspective regardless of the disability
- to facilitate entertainment for elderly and mobility impaired tourists

We will have preestablished routes in accordance with BCP recommendations and regulations









"Van Raam offers sustainable and contemporary mobility to people with a disability."


